TAPORI is a worldwide network of children whose motto is:

"We want all children to have the same chances!"

The name Tapori was chosen by Joseph Wresinski as a sign of solidarity with the poorest children. Joseph Wresinski, founder of the International Movement ATD Fourth World, grew up in poverty. While travelling in India, he met very poor children called *Taporis* who lived in train stations and who supported each other. He later wrote to other children: **"You are like the Taporis when you look out for others. You can find ways to make the world a better place and get rid of poverty."**

Today, thousands of children between 7 and 13 years old, across many different countries and continents, are connected through the Tapori newsletter.

Rules of the game



1. 2-8 players
2. Cut out the cards on pages 3 and 4. Mix them up and put them in the middle of the table with the Taporis logos facing up.
3. The oldest player picks a card.
4. If the card has:
 - **a message**, the player answer it.
 - **the image of a country**, the player says something about that country
 - **the image of Laetitia "Every child's story is important"**, the player talks about a child they admire: a child who helps their family, who does well at school, who is good at getting along with other children etc.If the player can't answer, ask the player to their right, or the next player etc.
5. Then the player at their left draws a card and answers.
Keep going around the circle until all the cards have been drawn.



At the end, do something together to show your friendship!
