# Searching for our human treasures

#### Leaders' guide

Here we give you some ideas of questions to help the children think, but feel free to do things differently.


As much as possible, it is very important to keep a record of what the children will share.

You can take notes or record the conversations.

The children answer the questions first individually and then as a group.



#### Sharing ideas about treasures:



- Is it only something material? Are there people, ways of acting or places that are treasures too?
  What are they? Why?
- What is the most precious treasure each of you have?
- In our environment, there are both personal treasures or common and collective ones. What are they?
- If people were treasures, how would we talk about them?

## Sharing ideas about how their treasure will be stored:

On a more personal level, each child has its own way of preserving what is precious to him or her. For example, in a drawer in its room, under the bed, in a notebook... Or by entrusting it to someone. Where does each child put its precious things?

As a community, the way we care for our treasures varies according to local culture, traditions, history...

How does it work in ours? How do we conserve our treasures?

The examples of Burkina Faso and Peru can inspire you.

If the children do not have any ideas, they could go and ask people around them and bring their ideas to the next Tapori meeting.

After sharing them, the children agree on what means will be used to collect their treasure.



## Setting to work!



- 3.1 If it is an object that will collect their treasure, the group can start work on creating it. Think together: How will you make it? Which materials will you need?
- 3.2 If it is a place or person, the group can photograph, draw, sculpt or find another way to represent it.
